



Bond Bridge Pro Set Up Instructions



Set Up BOND Bridge Pro Using WiFi

1. The Bond Bridge Pro can be connected to a WiFi network or an Ethernet cable and depending on this connection the center ring will be different on initial set up. If you are using a RJ45 connection powered or not, the center ring will be solid green at initial set up verses flashing green.
2. Provide power to the Bond using:
 - the USB power adapter and cable; or
 - POE.
3. When setting up the Bond Bridge Pro using WiFi, there is no need to connect an Ethernet cable to the Bond Bridge Pro.
4. Open the BOND application.
5. If you already have a BOND account, simply log in and continue to the next step. If you do not have a BOND account press “Create account” and enter your name, email, and a password.

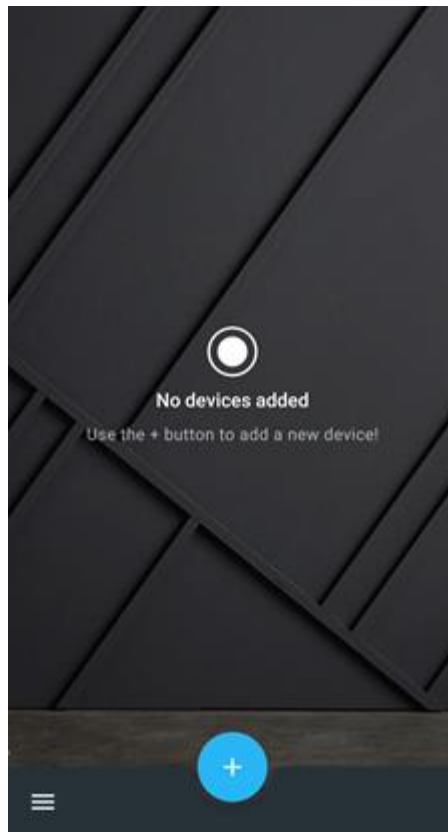

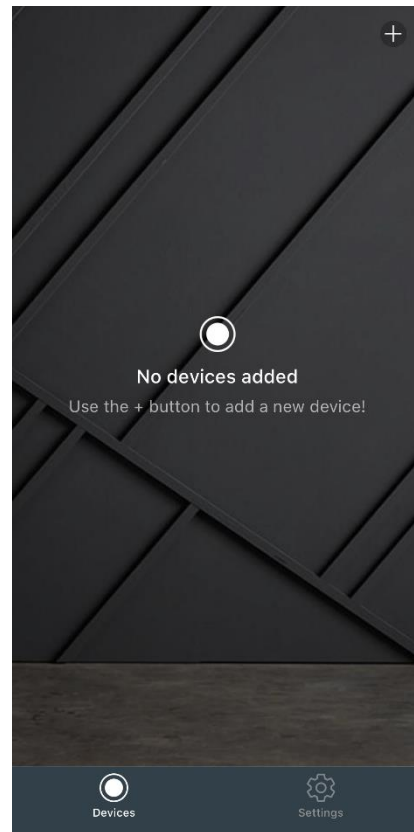

Select the QR scanner icon  at the top to scan the QR code  which is on the sticker located on the underside of the Bond Bridge Pro.

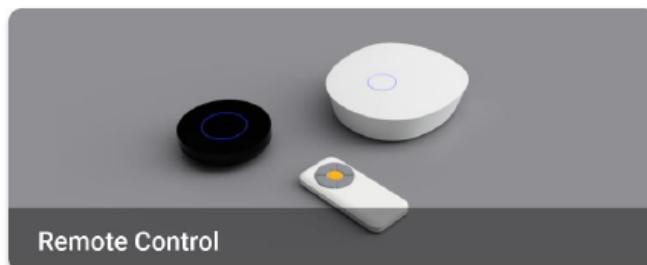
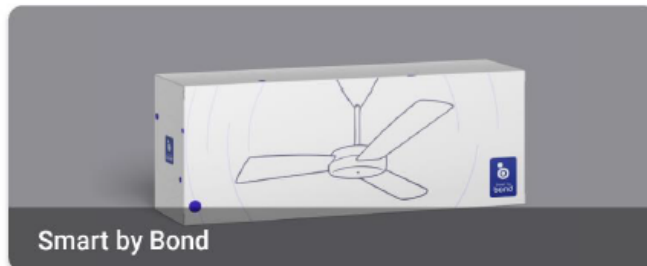

7. Select Bond Bridge Pro if not using the QR code

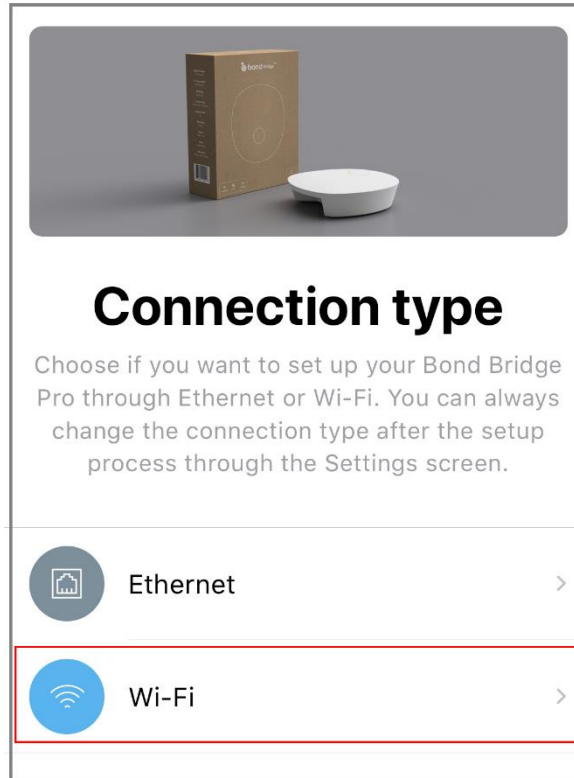

8. Select how your Bond Bridge Pro is connected to your network.



9. Select **WiFi** - If the center ring is not flashing green, please select "It's not flashing green" and you will be directed to a help file for instructions on how to perform a hardware reset.
10. Select **Continue**.
11. Select the bond Bridge Pro configuration WiFi (Serial number) in the Android application.
12. Go to Settings / WiFi and select the Bond Bridge Pro serial number as a WiFi connection in iOS and go back to the Bond Home application.
13. Select a location name from the list or choose other and add your own.
14. Give your Bond Bridge Pro a Unique name.

15. Select continue.

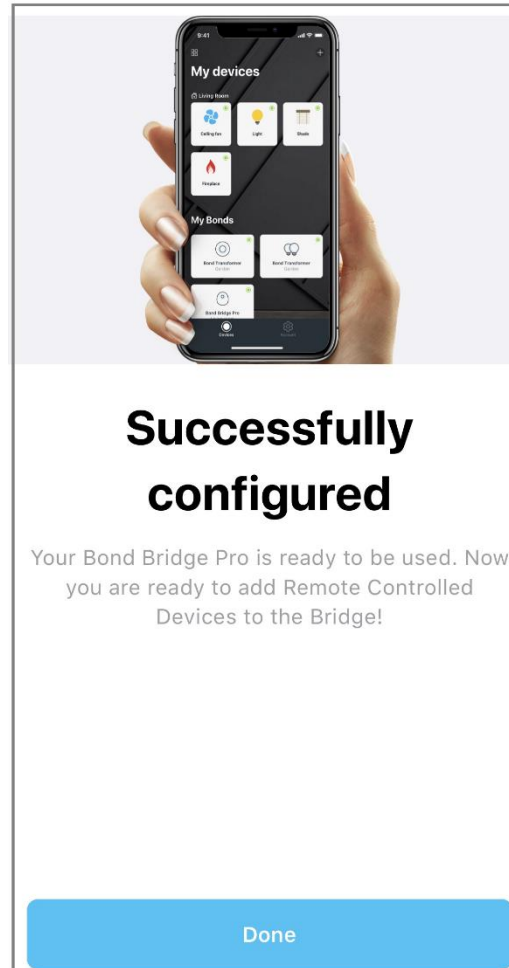

Set Up BOND Bridge Pro Using Ethernet

1. The Bond Bridge Pro can be connected to a WiFi network or an Ethernet cable and depending on this connection the center ring will be different on initial set up. If you are using a RJ45 connection powered or not, the center ring will be solid green at initial set up verses flashing green.
2. Provide power to the Bond using:
 - the USB power adapter and cable; or
 - POE.
3. Plug the network Ethernet cable to the Bond Bridge Pro.
4. Open the BOND application.
5. If you already have a BOND account, simply log in and continue to the next step. If you do not have a BOND account press “Create account” and enter your name, email, and a password.

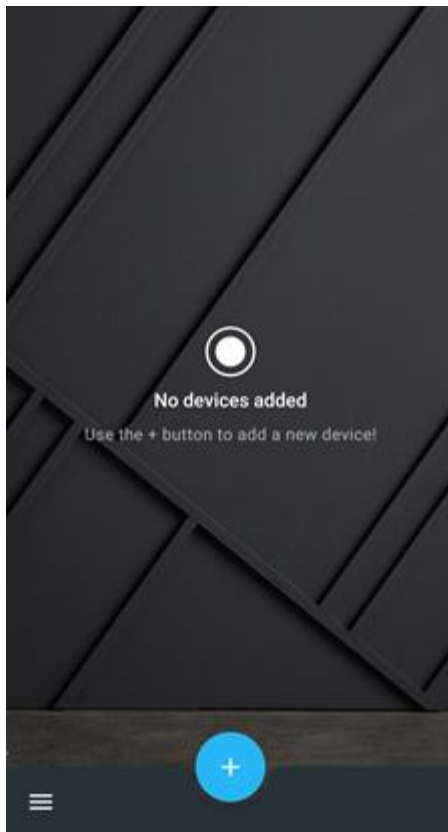

7. Select Bond Bridge Pro if not using the QR code

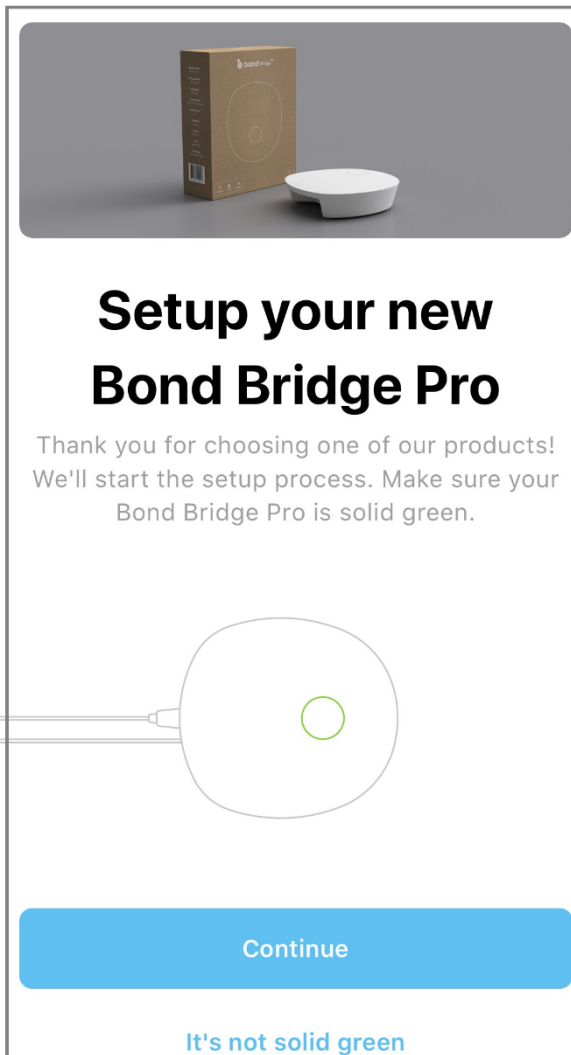
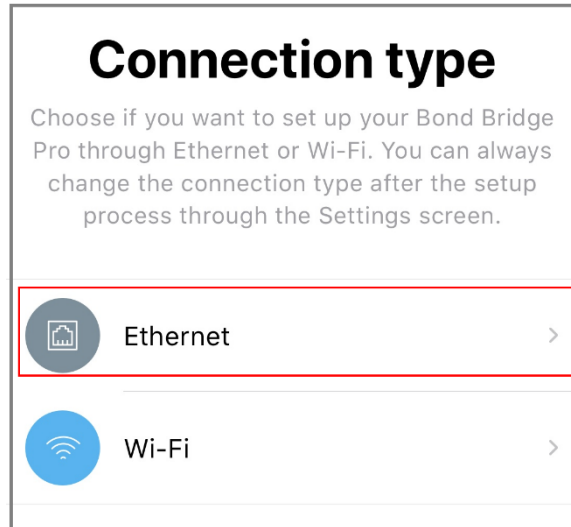

9. Select **Ethernet**.

- If the Bond Bridge center ring is flashing green, please confirm the Ethernet connection being used is working.
- If the center ring is not green, please select "It's not solid green" and you will be directed to a help file for instructions on how to perform a hardware reset.

10. Select **Continue**.

11. Choose the serial number for the bond bridge pro you want to set up.

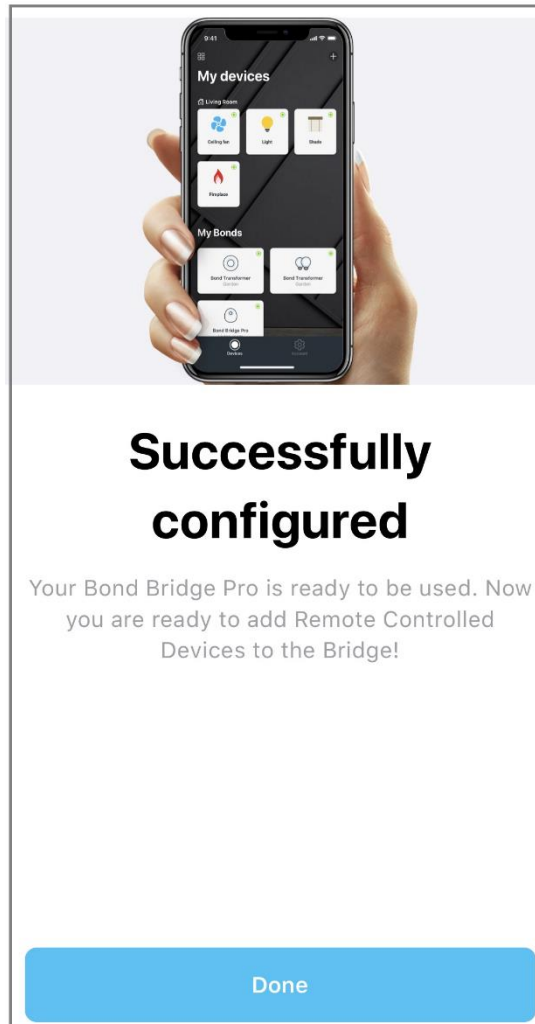
